

- This Show/Event supports the RAS 'In-Line Resolution Process' Policy AND Clean Sport Rules AND Arrears Policy
- Entries Close: Monday, November 6th 2023
- Entries MUST be entered under the name of the owner of the animal or lessee name if the lease has been registered with the RAS.
- After close of entries, if there are less than five (5) animals and/or three (3) exhibitors entered in the classes/sections, Nelson A&P Association may choose to amalgamate classes/sections as necessary.
- Entry Fees must be paid at close of entries. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Equestrian Administration team.
- Class changes and substitutions are at the discretion of the Equestrian Administration team unless a Vet Certificate is provided.
- No credit refunds will be given for class changes and substitutions made in the week before the Show.
- In the event that a horse is scratched a refund of all fees will be given minus the Equestrian
 & Admin Levy and the cost of any tickets issued if a Vet Certificate is provided.
- No Class will be held for late entrants or those that have entered multiple rings.

- Entry to the Show is through Gum Gate or if arriving on Friday or before 8.30am on Saturday and Sunday the main gate Washbourn Gates can be used. Redwood Gate is not available for use at all during the Show.


