RULES AND REGULATIONS

Te Kauwhata A & P Show is affiliated to the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand and operates under the Rules and Regulations of the RAS. www.ras.org.nz.

The 'In-Line' Resolution Process has been adopted by Te Kauwhata A&P Association. Full wording of the process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. A Yellow or Red Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behavior as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations / Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show / registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the person responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. If the matter is in regard to an RAS official, the show is to forward the concern on to the RAS Operations Manager to handle in an appropriate manner.

Clean Sport - The Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at risk of the person responsible.

Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

Arrears -No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

The Association will not be responsible for any accident in competitions or that may occur from machinery or other exhibits or plants belonging to exhibitors, competitors or the Association and it is a condition of entry that such exhibitor, competitor or visitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings issuing from any accidents so caused.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 and any amendments.

No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission from the Head Steward of that ring. Only persons directly responsible for an exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.

No classes will be held up for competitors competing in other rings, there are no exceptions.

A judicial committee comprising the President, Secretary and Chief Steward of the section concerned will adjudicate any protests. In the event of a conflict of interest an independent alternative will be appointed.

Membership: You can pay for, or renew a membership with your entry fees. Membership is \$12.00/annum.

GROUNDS FEES: \$10 per equestrian competitor (max \$30), \$5 per livestock (cattle, goat) competitor (max \$20).

MEDIC FEE: \$2.00 per entry will be applied

Dairy Cattle

Exhibitors Public Liability Insurance is compulsory (see rule 9). The names of all Purebred classes must be entered or eligible for entry in the recognised Herd Books or several Books.

All cattle shall wear a catalogue number when parading in the ring for judging, but no animal shall wear an award ribbon or card awarded in a previous class while in the ring for judging in any special class or in the opinion of the Chief Steward, is overstocked with milk.

The tying and taping of cow's teats must NOT be done: the Chief Steward has the power to order the removal of the same. All cattle must have the official NAIT tags in their ears.

All cattle entered in Group or Special Classes must be entered in at least one other class. No badges or ribbons other than those won at this show shall be displayed on stalls. No stock may leave the Showgrounds before 2:00 p.m. unless the Chief Steward gives special permission. Unattended stock trucks left at the loading ramp will be removed at the owner's risk. All Dairy Stock must lead and tie up. No bulldog clips are permitted for tethering or leading.

All Beef bulls 2 years & over must be rung and led through this ring.

All groups or pairs must be the property of the owner.

White coats or suitable uniform, no gumboots and no stud names showing, even on hats, are to be worn in the ring.

The attention of exhibitors is particularly drawn to the conditions relating to the misuse of drugs, and the intention of the Committee to undertake testing for forbidden substances at random through the Mid Northern Area. Your signature on the entry form and / or participation in the competition denotes acceptance of these conditions.

The Chief Steward reserves the right to split classes in this section if numbers warrant. Odds & Evens.

The Council reserves the right to exchange prize money for products of the same value when available.

Tuberculosis Testing:

The Herd Status Declaration Card: All cattle entered for showing which are 1 month of age and over must be accompanied in transit by the usual signed and dated TB Status Declaration card, showing either TB Free or C2 Status or better, in accordance with present law.

TB Test Certificate Accreditation:TB Movement Controlled Areas: Cattle 1 month of age and over which are farmed or grazed within a declared TB movement controlled area must be negative to a TB Test within 60 days prior to the start of the show.All cattle, yearlings and over, entered for showing must be shown from a TB – free, EBL free and Brucellosis accredited herd. Reminder: Exhibitors should be carrying their TB Declaration Card whenever transporting stock.
