- The age limit in the First Ridden section is under 10 years of age as at 1st August 2024.
- Ponies to be 138cm & under.
- Must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with a caveson noseband, a snaffle bit with a single rein.
- No spurs allowed. Cane or whip must not exceed 68cm in length including a flap 2cm wide by 4cm long.
- Riders who have competed in Open Sections are no longer eligible for First Ridden.
- The same pony may be entered in both the Lead Rein, First Ridden Section & Open ring but with a different rider.
- No cantering is allowed as a class. However, the judge may ask for canter in the individual workouts.
- In this section, the judging criteria is 60% suitability, temperament & safeness & 40% on conformation & paces.
- RAS Height/Performance certificates must be carried, failure to produce this will result in elimination.
- Classes may be split, combined or cancelled depending on entries

Pleasure Horse/Pony means those animals that do not fit the mould of a Show Horse/Pony. We welcome any breed (eg Appaloosas, Quarter Horses, Standardbred, Clyde X) and colour. They should be an uncomplicated and genuine pleasure to ride. Whilst they do not possess the show quality conformation of a show horse, they should in their own way be a delight to

ride, with impeccable manners. A "pleasure mount" is not an inexperienced mount with show quality conformation who is destined for the open show ring.

Pleasure Section Conditions:

- Riders in pony classes must be under 17 years (Proof of riders age may be requested). Age taken as at 1st August 2022.
- Adults may ride ponies in Horse classes.
- Snaffle bit only, no poll action.
- Plaiting is optional.
- Whips may be used but they must not be over 76cms in length. Dressage whips are not permitted.
- Spurs are not to be used.
- Dropped, grackle or flash nosebands are not permitted. Martingales, bit guards, training aids eg bearing, side, running or balancing reins, boots, bandages, any form of blinkers, ear plugs, hoods & shadow blinds are not permitted.
- Number holders to be worn.
- All riders must wear a current red or yellow tagged safety helmet.
- Classes may be split or combined should numbers deem it necessary. This will be decided by the committee after close of entries.
- Any child on a hack must rider in hack class.
